Effective January 1, 2016.

Monthly Basic Electric Charge

Single-Phase	\$36.00
Three-Phase.....	\$57.50

The **basic electric charge** covers your share of the cost to build and maintain the electric system that makes power available at your location. Every truck, transformer, wire, pole and meter costs money. All of this equipment—and the people to operate it—are needed to deliver electricity to your home, regardless of how much electricity you use. The basic charge is higher in rural areas because costs are shared among fewer members.

kWh Energy Charge

Winter, October - May.....	10.1¢
Summer, June - September.....	11.6¢

The **kWh energy charge** covers the cost of electricity you use, including its generation and transmission from the power plant. Rates are higher in summer because demand and wholesale power costs are higher. In January 2015, the summer rate period was shortened from six to four months.
