Policy No.: **M-23**

Subject: **Facility Relocation Due to Roadway Improvements**

Objective: To provide for cooperation when requested by state, county, or town governments to relocate Polk-Burnett facilities for roadway improvements.

Policy: Development and improvements to established roadways are necessary for continued progress in Polk-Burnett's service area. From time to time Polk-Burnett's facilities are in conflict with a proposed project. Facilities, which must be moved in order to complete such road projects, shall be relocated on the following basis:

- a. Facilities within the road right-of-way will be relocated at Polk-Burnett's expense. Every effort will be made to relocate on private lands and secure new easements.
- b. Facilities outside the road right-of-way will be relocated at the requestor's expense, and calculated at actual cost. Expenditures from modifications to existing Polk-Burnett facilities relating to and caused by the road project will also be borne by the requestor. Every effort will be made to relocate on private lands and secure new easements.
